JOB DESCRIPTION: Full-time Classroom **Teacher 1st Grade**

- Reflect the purpose of the school
- Cooperate with the Board and Administration in implementing all policies, procedures, and directives governing the operation of the school
- Develop integral curriculum based on a Biblical Worldview
- Implement curriculum and instruction in a manner consistent with PUCS mission statement, including understanding, modeling, and fostering independent thinking skills, creative problem solving, and abstract reasoning.
- Implement instructional approaches that reflect best practices for differentiation
- Teach classes as assigned following prescribed scope and sequence according to curriculum guidelines specified by PUCS
- Maintain ongoing curriculum evaluation to meet the needs of students
- Establish and maintain “Responsive Classroom” discipline within the classroom, on school property, and class field trips for a positive learning environment
- Plan broadly through the use of semester plans and objectives, and more short-term through the use of a weekly lesson plan book
- Utilize valid teaching techniques to achieve curriculum goals within the framework of the school’s philosophy
- Employ a variety of instructional aids, methods, and materials that will provide for creative teaching to reach the whole child
- Use homework effectively for drill, review, enrichment, and project work
- Assess student performance on a regular basis and provide progress reports as required
- Maintain portfolio materials which illustrate student progress
- Conduct parent/teacher and parent/student/teacher conferences in a manner consistent with the PUCS policy manual.
- Develop cooperative relationships with parents and students based on mutual respect and objectivity.
- Serve on various Board and Faculty committees
- Maintain valid PA Teacher Certification
- Acquire and update as required the three clearances required of school employees by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
